Submissions for Tools and Resources are open to collaborative groups/ stakeholders, related organizations and staff/management of long term care/retirement homes, and providers of innovative products and services relevant to long-term care. Multiple submissions from individuals or organizations are welcomed.

CRITERIA:

All submissions will be reviewed and will be adjudicated by a panel of researchers and practitioners, based on the following criteria:

- Significance to long term care or relevance to the theme of the research day
- Innovation of tool/resource in long term care
- Evidence of evaluation

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Tool/Resource Title
2. Purpose and Background (Why?)
3. Description (What?)
4. Evaluation/Lessons Learned
5. Appendices can include list of funders/sponsors; sample of tool/resource; evaluation outcomes, etc.
